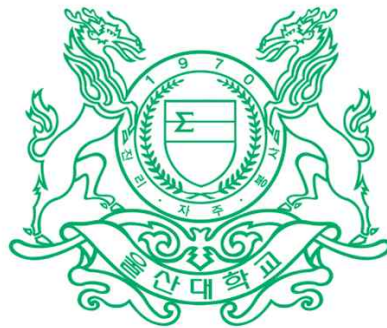

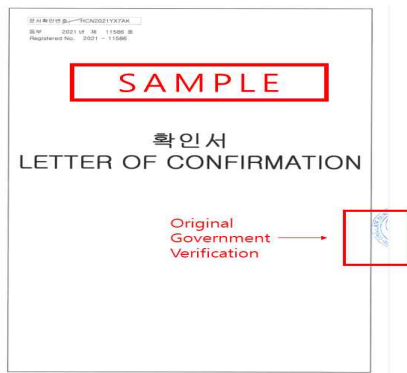
**7. Government Verification and Original Documents Submission**

- \* Government Verification should be done through one of the following ways.
  - 1) Apostille Verification
  - 2) Korean Consular Verification from a Korean Embassy or Consulate General in the country where the applicant's university is located.
  - 3) Consular Verification from the embassy of the country where the applicant's university is located, to Korea.
  - 4) Applicants who graduated from Chinese 4-year undergraduate programmes must submit an official report of their Graduation Certificate issued by CHSI/CSSD (學信網: China Credentials Verification) instead of the degree certificate.
    - CHSI website: [www.chsi.com.cn](http://www.chsi.com.cn)
  - 5) Verification and notarisation are not required for graduation certificates and academic transcripts issued by universities in Korea.

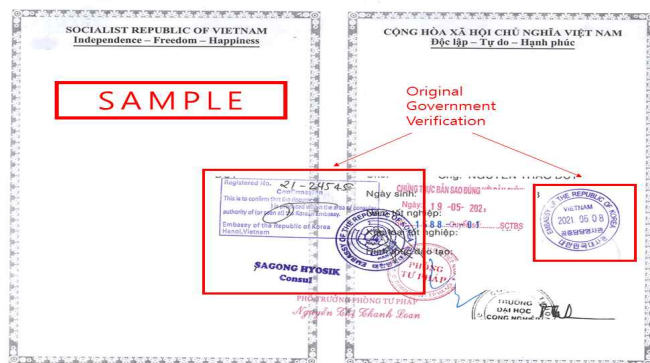
**# Sample Pictures for Additional Documents (Graduation Certificate)**

- \* When obtaining government verification for certificates of graduation, applicants must have the copies authenticated, not the original documents.
- \* All documents must be in Korean or English. If not, applicants must submit notarised translations in either Korean or English.
- \* Pakistani applicants must submit their certificates of graduation and transcripts with Pakistani Government Verification and Apostille on the copies, not the original documents. 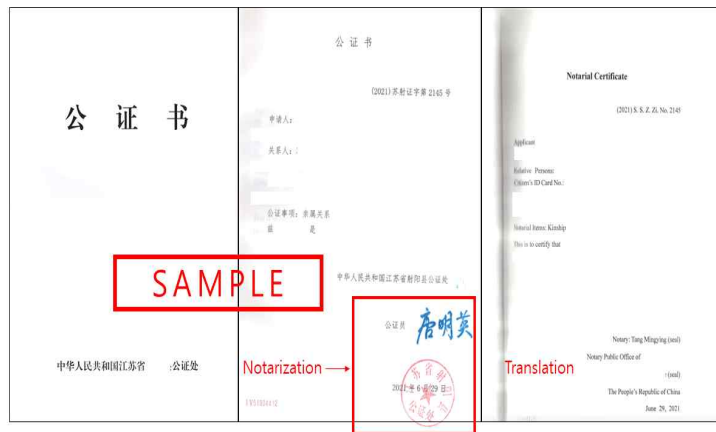

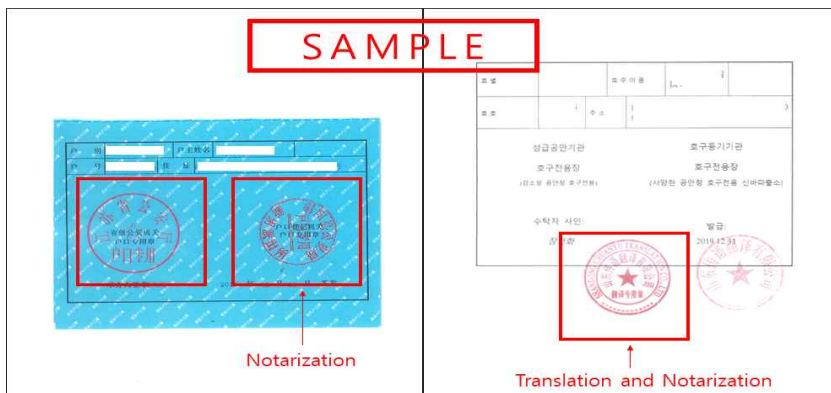
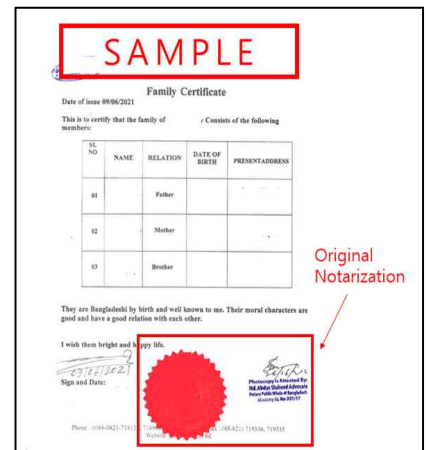
